About International Women's Day

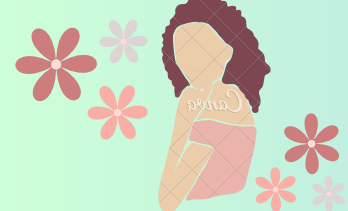
Marked annually on March 8th, International Women's Day is one of the most important days of the year to:
