Name of the Activity: Wildlife week- 2025 On spot quiz and drawing competition for school and college students



Name of the Activity: “Environment Day celebration Planet Vs. Plastic”



Name of the Activity: Innovations in life sciences: Bridging Academia and Entrepreneurship on 16th October 2025- Invited talk


