Brief summary of the activity:

On 22nd of August 2025 , Final year B.COM , students were taken to **RSG Brick Works** , located in Kunigal,as a part of industrial visit. This visit aimed to provide practical exposure to the students on understanding the Brick manufacturing process .This helps in bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world industrial applications. We boarded the bus around 7:30 a.m, reached the factory at 9:30 p.m and completed the visit at 1:00 p.m . As there were around 148 students, they were divided into 3 groups and were accompanied by 2 teachers for each bus .

RSG Brick Industry was established approximately eight years ago by Mrs. Ramya , alumna of our college with the support of her husband. Mrs.Ramya clearly explained the whole procedure of brick manufacturing that starts right from the collection of clay till the last step of dispatch . The industrial visit to RSG Brick Industry was highly informative and enriching. Students gained a clear understanding of production techniques, quality control, and the dynamics of running a small-scale industry. In addition to the industrial visit, we also had the opportunity to visit Sri Siddalingeshwara Swamy Shrine, Yediyur , and Markonahalli Dam , which added a cultural and recreational dimension to our day.


